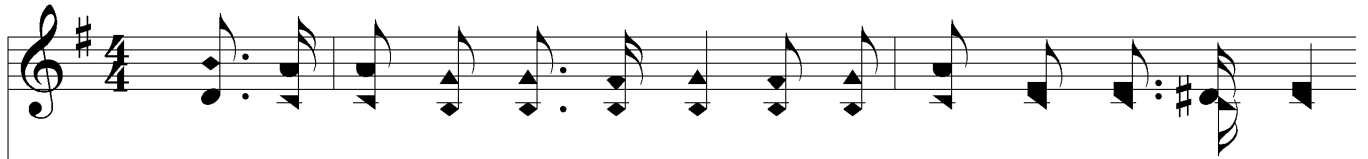



# There's Work to Do

There's a prom - ise in His Word laid down, Of a rest - ing by and by,



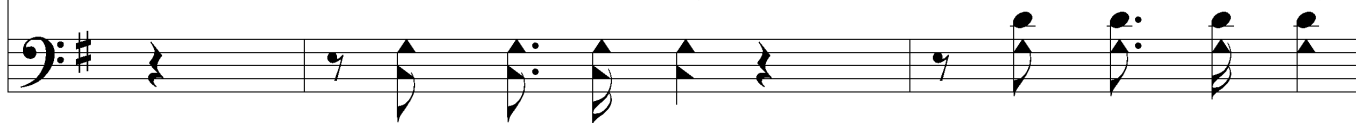
To the wea - ry hearts op - pressed, Let us has - ten at the Mas - ters call.
