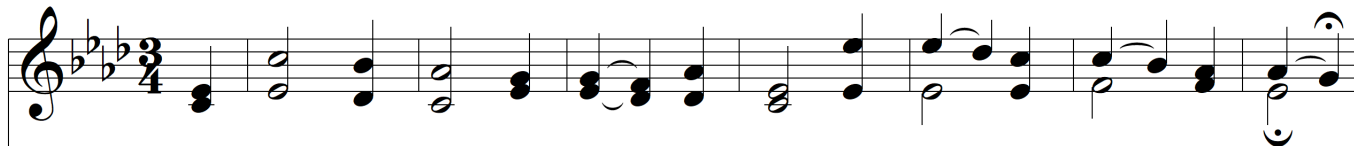
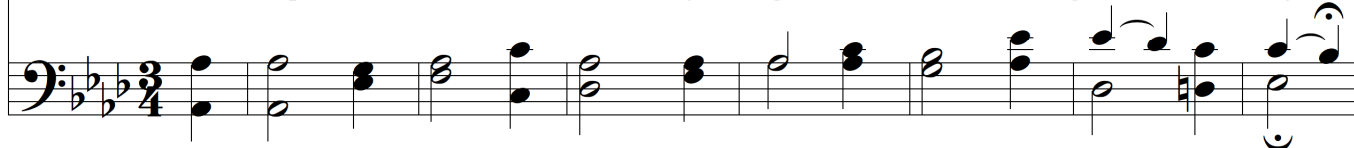


# How Precious Is The Book Divine
