
Give! said the thirst - y earth: ³ Down came the show'r;

Motion song if desired– 1) hands lifted from the left knee to the right shoulder. 2) arms folded and rocked. 3) hands moved downward from head to knees. 4) hands lifted. 5) Hands move upward. 6) hands move downward from left to right, fingers working. 7) flowing motion. 8) hands move downward. 9) point to the sun. 10) hand indication “Milky Way.” 11, 12, 13) point to the location of each in the sky. 14) hands move down-ward. 15) point-ing over the sea. 16) arms extended, hands open, showing offerings. *Chorus) all imitate receiving and passing on– both hands first to left, receiving; then to right, giving; in time with music.
