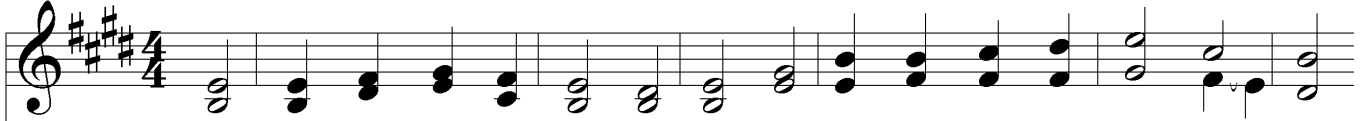


# Oh, Bow Thine Ear, Eternal One
