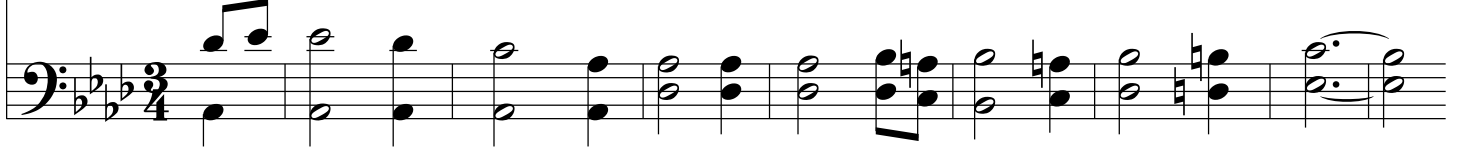


That Dreadful Night
