ANCIENT ORDER OF COMMON PRAYER

1. O be joyful in the *Lord*, all ye lands; [serve the Lord with gladness, and come before His pres - ence with a song.

3. O go your way into His gates with thanksgiving, and *into* His courts with praise; [be thankful unto *Him*, and speak good of His name.
